# **General partners**



**The Pilsen Region** is situated in the south-west of the Czech Republic. Its area of 7,561 km<sup>2</sup> makes it the third largest region, yet it is ninth in terms of population (570,000). It has the second lowest population density,

next to South Bohemia. Its longest border is in the south-west, with Bavaria, Germany. The Region's great asset is its position between Prague and the countries of Western Europe. The Pilsen Region offers diverse natural conditions. In terms of the main watercourses, the Berounka River basin accounts for the largest part of the Pilsen Region. The territory of the Region includes the Šumava Nature Park, four protected landscape areas (Šumava, Český les, Slavkovský les, and Křivoklátsko), and over 180 smaller reservations. The nature of the landscape and its varied population density and industrial concentration result in a great diversity of animal and plant species. The mountain ranges of the Český les and the Šumava are among the most interesting parts of the Region. Velká Mokrůvka (1370 m) in the Šumava Mountains is the highest point of the Pilsen Region. The Pilsen Region is an economically developed region. Its high ranking on the national scale is due to the high economic performance of the City of Pilsen, which is estimated to account for nearly two thirds of the total GDP of the Pilsen Region.
